Mens and Ladies Teams have survived to fight another day in Group 1 but at the Winter Cup last weekend both teams were relegated. Good efforts made by all and all credit to the players. Congratulations expressed to Jeff Wayne and Sarah Donovan for leading the teams. We have good competitive tennis in Hertfordshire and good facilities. This year the LTA initiated a large restructure of their organisation with the ultimate aim of achieving more people playing tennis, more often. Herts Tennis is still here keen to help clubs and players in very way we can but additional support is now being provided by our Regional LTA office. Batchwood Sports Centre is now open again following the devastating fire there three years ago. Congratulations and thanks were expressed to all who contributed to the successful rebuilding programme.

Junior Performance and results are detailed on pages 6/7 of the Newsletter. Much success at Junior level including being Winners of Lionel Cox. Fantastic performances at every age group. Individual success of Herts Players. Ed Corrie, David Rice and Katy Dunne reached career high singles ranking of ATP 216, ATP 298 and WTA 310 respectively. George Coupland retired on Singles ranking of ATP 588. Herts Junior County Closed tournament was very successful and well attended and Herts wish to further grow this tournament.
