CREATING TENNIS OPPORTUNITY AND EXPERIENCES FOR JUNIOR TENNIS PLAYERS

The Herts Inspires My Tennis Future programme is for Hertfordshire qualifying tennis players in school year 10 and above who are actively involved in tennis and have a keen interest in exploring and / or pursuing tennis as a career or university pathway, developing their game and expanding their tennis knowledge and experience

The annual programme will provide selected participants with:

- * Experience days “Working in the World of Tennis”
- * Volunteer opportunities through Tennis Pay Back at county events
- * Higher Education and Careers advice / guidance
- * On court workshops and access to performance squads
- * Opportunity for discount on Ucoach - LTA Assistant / Instructor courses
- * Access to LTA Tennis Leaders Courses at reduced cost
- * Opportunity to advance personal playing levels
- * Involvement in a recognised county programme
- * Participants t-shirt

On completion of the commitment participants qualify for:

- * Award of a Certificate of Achievement detailing level of attendance, commitment and professionalism
- * Opportunity to request references for employment / university / DofE
- * Opportunity to apply for ongoing career path training / support

Annual commitment: criteria

- 1 - Attend one on-court training workshop and one career workshop
- 2 - Attend two “Working in the World of Tennis” days
- 3 - Volunteer at one Herts Tennis Pay Back event
- 4 - Attend an annual event for all participants
- 5 - Submit an end of programme report
- 6 - Uphold the Herts Tennis values and be a positive tennis ambassador
- 7 - Uphold the Herts Player “Commitment to Fair Play & Professional Conduct”

Additional opportunities

- 1 - Support with steps to achieving coaching qualifications
- 2 - Involvement in County Training & team preparations as a hitter/assistant
- 3 - Opportunity to attend Performance Squad Training
- 4 - Potential to provide hitting/assistant services to Herts Juniors / clubs

Discounted Coach Education Course Fees

LTA Leaders Course = minus 15%

Ucoach LTA Level 1 Assistant = minus 15% / LTA Level 2 Instructor = minus 10%

Five spaces per course and discount applies to courses taken within 18 months of starting the programme
